## Let FEP work for you!

## What is FEP?

FEP is a special program for individuals participating in VIEW to obtain paid work experience for up to six months. A FEP Participant will earn a pay check and continue to receive TANF benefits. Start by talking with your worker about a FEP job you'd be interested in and then interview with the employer. If it seems like a good match for you and the employer, then accept the job offer and start working!

This sounds like a good opportunity, but what happens to my TANF case?

It is a wonderful work opportunity! Your TANF case will stay open. During placement in FEP employment, you must continue to report required changes. Although the information does not affect eligibility for TANF, the changes may impact your eligibility and benefits for SNAP and Medicaid.

I may need to increase my job skills before I have much to offer an employer. Can FEP help with that?

Definitely. One of the great advantages of FEP is that you actually get training on the job – while you work and get paid!

## What's in it for the employer?

There are several benefits for the employer – beginning with you, a good employee! Additionally, the employer will receive a FEP payment to help offset the costs of training and running the program. If the FEP job works out, then the employer may be able to hire you permanently which will save the business the cost of hiring and training someone new.
