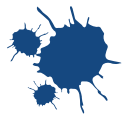
HAZARDOUS PRODUCT



LESS TOXIC OPTIONS



PROPER DISPOSAL



STAINS/FINISHES

Components: Glycols, ethers, ketones, minerals, spirits, toluene, xylene, other volatile organic compounds.

WATER-BASED FINISHES

Store in screw-top container. Drop off at Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Center.



OIL-BASE PAINTS

Components: Glycols, ethers, ketones, minerals, spirits, toluene, xylene, other volatile organic compounds.

WATER-BASED PAINTS

Share leftovers. Drop off at HHW Center.



USED-OIL

Components: Hydrocarbon, heavy metals.

NONE; USE RECYCLED OIL

Recycle. Contact oil collection center or service station. Drop off at HHW Center.



BLEACH CLEANERS

Components: Lye, hydrogen peroxide, sodium or calcium hypochlorite.

BAKING SODA

Use as intended in well-ventilated area. Never mix with ammonia. Drop off at HHW Center.



AMMONIA-BASED CLEANERS

Components: Ammonia, ethanol.

WHITE VINEGAR, LEMON JUICE

Use as intended in well-ventilated area. Never mix with chlorine bleach. Drop off at HHW Center.



DRAIN OPENER

Components: Lye, sodium hypochlorite.

PREVENT BLOCKAGE with biological clog preventers; remove clogs with plunger or Plumber's snake

Drop off at HHW Center.



OVEN CLEANER

Components: Lye, Ammonia.

CATCH DRIPS with foil or cookie pan; for cleaning, baking soda, water and scouring pad

Use as intended in well-ventilated area. Drop off at HHW Center.



PESTICIDES

Components: Visit US EPA for a list of banned pesticides..

REMOVE FOOD SOURCE, use traps and baits or biological controls

Drop off at HHW Center.



PAINT THINNER

Components: Alcohol, acetone, esters, ketones, petroleum, distillates, other volatile organic compounds.

WATER IN WATER-BASED PAINT

Store in screw top container. Allow paint solids to settle to bottom and pour off clear thinner to reuse. Drop off remainder at HHW Center.



*WATER-BASED LATEX PAINT

Components: Not considered hazardous.

Share leftovers. Add kitty litter or sawdust to leftovers to allow paint to dry. Trash dried paint or drop off at HHW Center.
